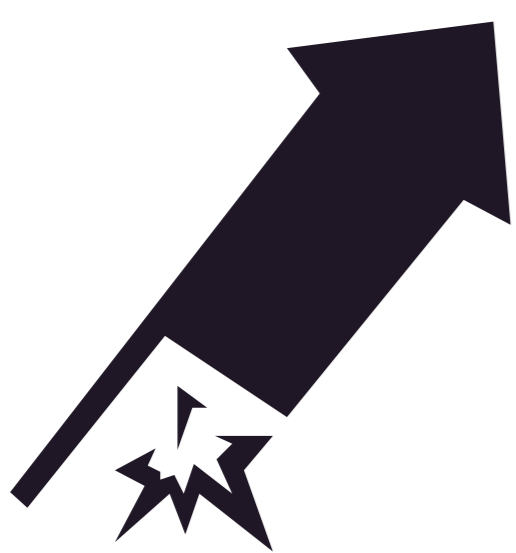

Examples of forbidden dangerous goods are as follows;

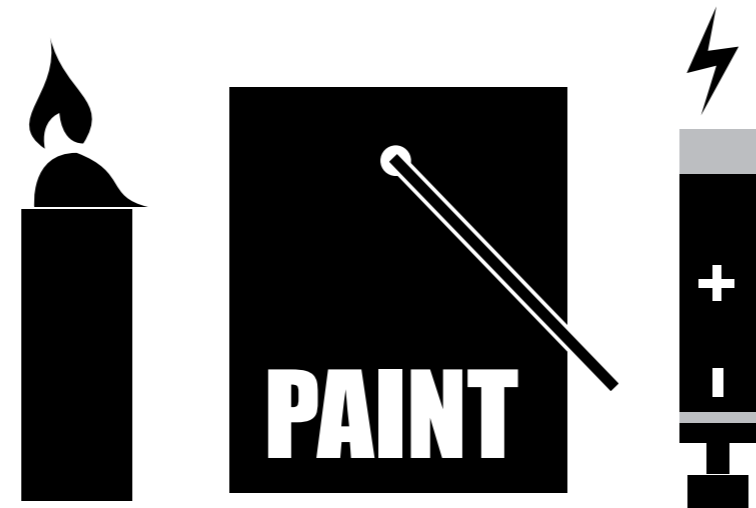
Explosives

Grenades, fireworks & flares



Flammable liquids & solids

Gasoline, methanol, magnesium & firelighters



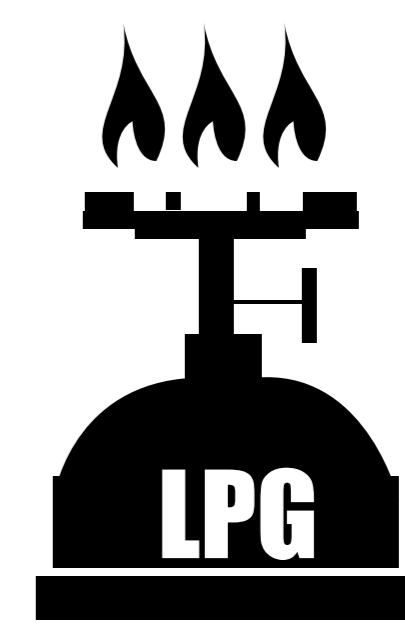
Oxidizers / Organic peroxide

Bleach, acids, car body repair kits, solvents, cleaners



Gases

Camping gas, portable gas stove, propane, butane



Weapons

Firearms, gun powder ammunition, tear gas, pepper spray



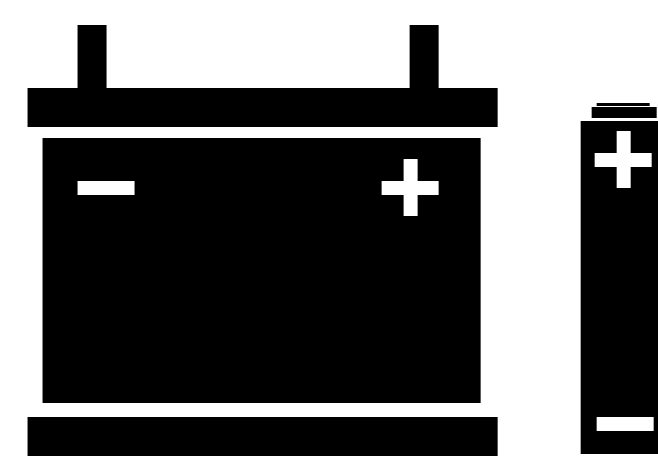
Pressure containers

Spray cans, scuba tanks, butane fuel, propane tanks, CO2 cartridges



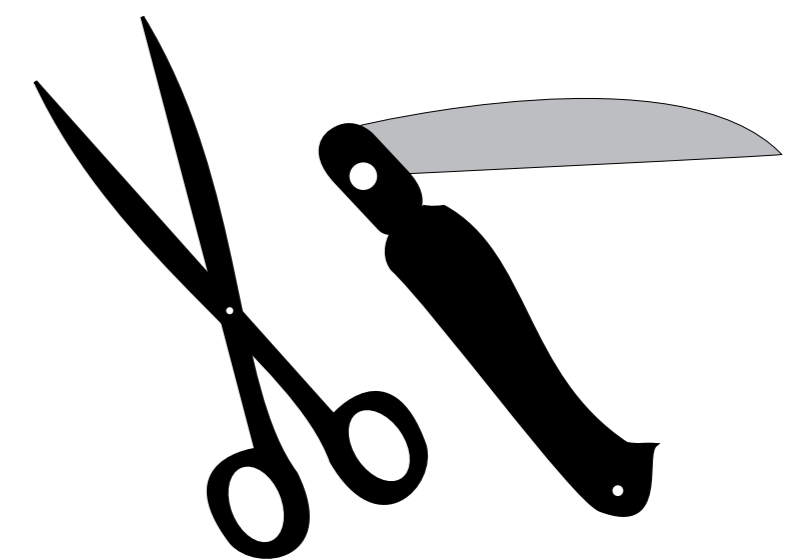
Corrosives

Mercury, vehicle batteries, lithium ion batteries, Wet cell batteries



Knives of any kind

Knives, scissors, other sharp objects



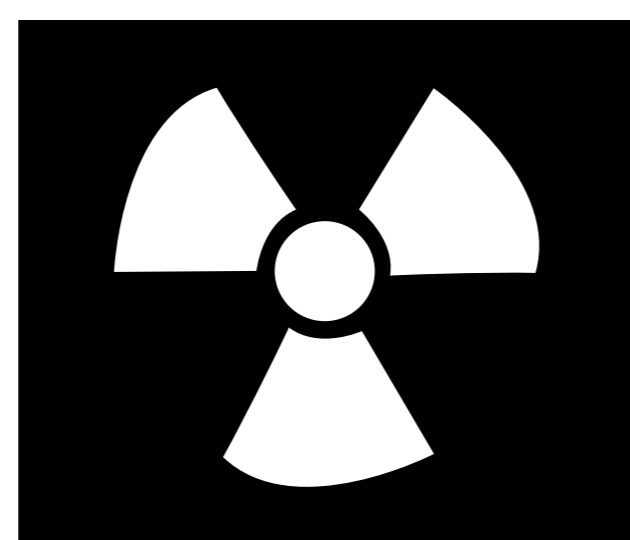
Other hazardous materials

Dry ice, asbestos, adhesives, vehicle fuel system component

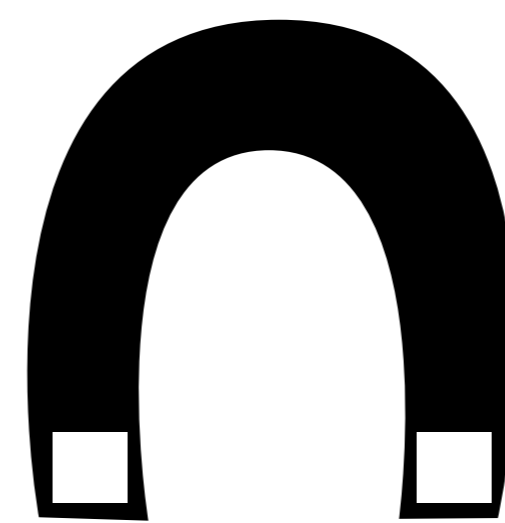


Radioactive materials

Medicinal or commercial isotopes

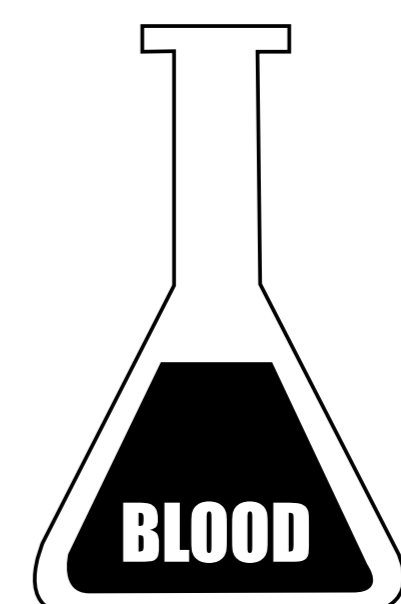


Magnetized materials
