



Across Border Documentation Requirements and procedures



Have you ticked all the boxes?

Airkenya prides itself in being the premier Domestic Airline that connects East Africa's touristic destinations.

Among the services we provide include:

- **Mara-Serengeti - Mara** via Migori and Tarime respectively
- **Mara-Entebbe - Mara** via Kisumu
- **Wilson – Kilimanjaro - Wilson** Non-stop flights

These flights depart and arrive in Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda. We would therefore require our customers to have the right travel documents and be adequately prepared for their journey.

The documents mentioned below are mandatory and required at the border to clear customs, immigration and to complete security formalities. They will also facilitate transit at entry and exit points.

Mara Serengeti Mara

This service connects our customers from Kenya's **Masai Mara** to the **Serengeti** via **Migori** and from Tanzania's **Serengeti** to **Kenya's Masai Mara** via **Isebania border**.

The flights are operated by Airkenya Express and its Tanzanian Subsidiary Regional Air Services and will also use our Tanzanian preferred partners: Coastal Aviation and Auric Air Services.

- Point of customs and immigration is at the Isebania border (Kenya) and Sirare border (Tanzania)

This is the only service that has an Airkenya/Regional Air surface transfer between Migori/Isebania and Tarime/ Sirare border. The flight is booked as Mara – Tarime – Serengeti -Mara.

Mara Entebbe.....Mara

This service connects our customers both ways from Kenya's **Masai Mara** to **Entebbe Int Airport** and from **Entebbe Int Airport** to Kenya's **Masai Mara** via **Kisumu**.

Airkenya Express operates the sectors Maasai Mara-Kisumu-Entebbe-Kisumu and Aerolink Uganda (Airkenya's subsidiary) operates Entebbe-Uganda National Parks destinations-Entebbe sectors. Both services will provide convenient connections and handling to expedite transit from one Airline to the other.

- Point of customs and immigration is at Kisumu International Airport in Kenya and Entebbe International Airport in Uganda.

Ebola Screening: is part of the arrival Procedure at both Kisumu and Entebbe Airports. This is usually done without delays.

Wilson Kilimanjaro Wilson

Customers flying from the **Masai Mara, Lewa Downs, Samburu, Nanyuki, Meru, Amboseli**, will connect with the Airkenya's Wilson-Kilimanjaro service from its hub at Wilson Airport. This flight will later connect with Regional Air's flights to **Arusha airport, Serengeti destinations, Dar es Salaam** and **Zanzibar**.

- Customs and Immigrations formalities will be done at Wilson Airport, and on arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport



Your Check list:

Passports

Need to have at least 6 months validity from entry date.

Visas

Visas can be issued at the border of Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda; however we highly recommend that customers obtain their entry visas in advance.

This can be done prior to travel through embassies or foreign affairs departments of visiting countries.

Alternatively **E- visas** can also be applied through official government sites - Links provided below.

By holding a pre- applied Visa, customers will avoid long queues during peak times; it will also minimize connection times.

Also note that money transactions at the border can be time consuming. Access to ATM machines, cash operations, currencies acceptance, may all delay issuance of entry visas.

NOTE: on the Mara –Entebbe –Mara via Kisumu flights.

Visitors in possession of the common East African tourist Visa do not need to apply for a Visa to enter Uganda.

Yellow Fever Vaccination

Yellow Fever Vaccination: Persons falling in the age bracket between 9 months to 59 years old travelling to or living in an area where the risk of yellow fever infection is known to exist, or travelling to a country where the yellow fever vaccination is required i.e. Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, require proof of a World Health Organization Immunization certificate.

Exemption: Adults **60 years** of age and older who cannot avoid travel to a yellow fever area, should discuss the health hazards of such vaccination with their doctors prior to leaving their home country.

If necessary your Doctor may issue a waiver letter/certification that a yellow fever vaccination cannot be administered due to health reasons. It is always advisable to consult with the Embassies of the countries you plan to visit to confirm that this procedure is acceptable by the relevant arrival health authorities.

Airkenya Express, Regional Air Service Tanzania and **Aerolink Uganda** have ground staff at entry/ exit points and will be able to assist you during your transit and answer any queries you may have.
